

Calendar for Moon-Venus conjunctions 2025

From last day of visibility, Venus will move into an exterior conjunction with the Sun on 6. January 2026 at $16^{\circ}22' \text{♊}$.

From there she begins her ascent as an evening star, and her first day of visibility will be 16. February 2026 at $8^{\circ}10' \text{♋}$, and her journey upwards through the chakras will begin and continue through the Venus-Moon conjunctions until the next interior conjunction between Venus and the Sun which will take place on 24. October 2026 at $00^{\circ}45' \text{♌}$.

And a new Venus cycle begins.

26. November $24^{\circ}26' \text{♍}$
